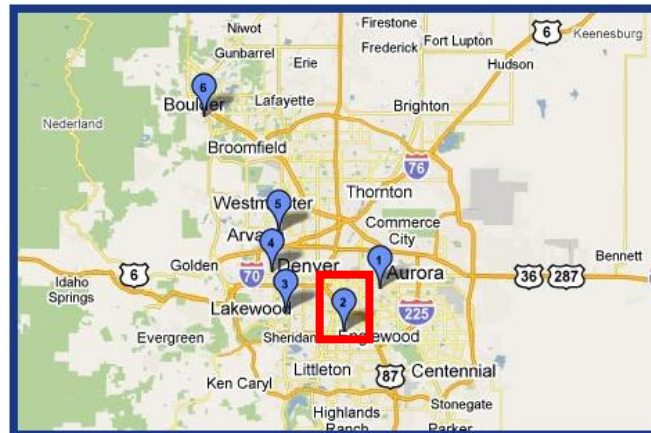
Free Parking for the Meridian is located South of the building or on the street. There should be plenty of available parking in the lot. Check website for room and speaker information.

According to the ancient Egyptians, the Phoenix was handsome red and gold bird about the size of an eagle. It would fly into Egypt every 500 years to build a nest, and burn itself in order to regenerate itself out of the ashes. The whole process sounded so heroic and immortal that, from the days of the Romans, the Phoenix and its flaming nest became a symbol of royalty. The United Ostomy Association of America, Inc. uses the Phoenix to symbolize ostomates "reborn from the ashes of disease."
